The *33rd Annual Relay Challenge Meet* will be held on September 8-9, 2023; we would like to welcome back our previous sponsor <u>Swim Zone</u>. We are sure this meet will continue to live up to the expectations of all who have attended in the past and we welcome those new to the concept! The diving portion of the relays will be on Friday evening at Northeast High School Pool, and the swimming relays will be at North Shore Pool on Saturday.

We will continue the traditional format of the meet! This means that we will be cheering in the end of the pool in the break times and Spirit Trophies will be awarded in each division. Following are the categories in which each team can earn points toward those Spirit Trophies.

The **THEME** of this year's meet is **SCHOOL SPIRIT**. Think of how you can use your school colors and represent your school in each of these areas:

**Team Area Decoration** - decorate your team area to represent your school with posters and other items that can hang from your tent. Just make sure that your designs are safe for the pool deck (no glitter).

**Pool Cheers** – each team will perform two cheers, one on the deck and one in the pool, as loud and as supportive as they can. Each cheer must be less then 1 minute.

**Non-Perishable Food Drive** – To add a service element to the event, collect nonperishable food items as a team. Bring your collection to the meet. Swimming will be held Saturday, September  $9^{+}$  at 9:30 a.m. at Northshore Pool with the pool opening for warm-ups at 7:30 a.m. (teams will be provided their warm-up time and lane assignments) Gates will open at 7:15 am for team set up.

Floats and vehicles are <u>NOT</u> allowed on the pool deck and NO marching (snakes) in the pool during break. No body paint or glitter, due to interference with pool and facility equipment!

We will have awards and will continue to recognize winners for all classes as well as Spirit awards and heat winners. We will also have music to make this meet enjoyable!

The entry is fee is as follows; \$150 girls <u>or</u> boys; \$275 <u>both</u> girls & boys teams; \$125 diving only. All checks should be made payable to Northeast High School and fees are due by the beginning of the meet.
