Entries:	There is a team entry limit of four (4) swimmers/divers per individual event. Each school is allowed to enter one (1) relay team per relay event. Each athlete is limited to entering four events, no more than two of which may be individual events.
Entry Deadline:	The Meet Entry File is due to <u>meetsupport@accurateswimtiming.com</u> by Sunday October 22 BY 5:00 pm. Head coaches will be sent an email confirmation upon receipt of entries.
Entry Notes:	Coaches should enter swimmers/relays with best yard times, or NT. Coaches are required to send all swimming and diving entries using HY- TEK software. Coaches are asked to use the provided meet entry file. It may be obtained from Ben Brewer.
Entry Fees:	Checks shall be made payable to East River High School and can be mailed to: East River High School 650 E River Falcons Way Orlando, FL 32833
Psych/Heat Sheets:	Once entries are processed, the Psych Sheet will be sent to the coaches for review. No changes to events may be made once the Psych Sheet has been published, unless clerical in nature. The Heat Sheet will be distributed via email to head coaches.
Deck entries:	Deck entries are not allowed for this meet.
Timers:	Each School will provide 2 timers. Timers will be admitted free of charge. NTC will provide all timer equipment and lap counters. Please email your volunteer list to Ben Brewer at <u>Benjamin.brewer@ocps.net</u> so that we can make sure they do not have to pay at the gate.
Awards:	Trophies will be provided for the first-place Boys team and the first-place girls team.
Coaches Meeting:	Coaches and captains meeting will be held during warm-ups and run by the Meet Referee. Meeting times will be announced at the meet.
Gate Openings and A	<b>dmission Fee:</b> Spectator gate will open at 8:00. Admission is \$8.00 per spectator, and tickets must be purchased in advance at Go Fan (www.gofan.co).

Jury of Appeals: Head coaches from East River, Lyman, Edgewater, and Winter Springs.

Camera Zones: Per FHSAA, meet management shall designate and inform the public of 'Camera Zones" at each meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable 'Camera Zones' may include but are not limited to the side course of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, and turn-end of the pool when not in use as the start end. Meet management shall also designate 'No Camera Zones'. Under NO circumstances will camera zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course while they are in use for 'race starting purposes' during competition and warm up. No camera zones also include locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area.

Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the FHSAA Code of Conduct violation.
