## SZAG Championship Meet Gets Underway

Swimmers were greeted by some extreme heat as they entered the Rosen Aquatic & Fitness Center for the 45th Annual SZAG Championship Meet. As the meet began, host LSC Florida turned up the heat in the pool in the 13-14 Girls 800m Freestyle with their swimmers going 1st, 3rd and 4th. The 13-14 Boys followed with Jack Reburn and Porter DeBruin swimming first and third, respectively, giving Florida an early lead in the team standings.

The distance events were followed by the 400m Free and 400m Medley relay events. In the relays, North Carolina showed off their depth with the A and B relays scoring in seven of the eight relay events contested. At the end of Day One, the NCS squad moved into first place by 74 points (see the complete Team Standings on page three).

After the meet concluded on Wednesday, all athletes and coaches were invited to the Social event hosted at Icon Park across the street from the Aquatic Center and catered by Brother Jimmy's Barbecue.
