As we enter the final day of competition, teams are already jockeying for bragging rights in the team scoring until next year. Only two points separate Georgia and Southeastern as they battle for fourth place and just six points separate South Carolina and Florida Gold in the race for 6th place.

Great swims continue to light up the

scoreboard and Friday night was no exception. Eight new Futures cuts were smashed and one Zone Record fell in the 13-14 Boys 200m Breast-stroke as Edmond Reynolds of South Texas captured his second Zone Record of the meet, by just over a second. The previous record had been in place since 2010. The eight Futures cuts were achieved by Andrew Kruger (KY) in the 200m Fly;

in the 50m Free by Mary Louis Russ (MS), Kate Whatley (SES), and Chandler Daigle (NC); and in the 200m Breast by Mia Lang (NC), Margaret Verina (FG), Edward Reynolds (STX), and Nicolay Chernev (GA).

With the final day of competition about to get going, there is even more fast swimming yet to come. Watch for our fourth issue which will post on Monday.

Meet Landon Baker: Canadian Turned Texan

At age 14, Landon Baker has already experienced a lot. In the last year, he and his family moved from Alberta, Canada to Midland, Texas which took three days by car during which he got to see hundreds of square miles of the United States.

Landon began swimming at a young age (2nd or 3rd Grade) after being coaxed into it by his older sister, Gracie. His favorite events are currently freestyle and backstroke and although he prefers the shorter sprint events, he has begun to up his game dabbling in longer events. On Friday he dropped nearly 9 seconds in his 200m Freestyle race.

His favorite thing about the Southern Zone Meet is being able to swim with many more swimmers and to meet other para competitors.

"The meet provides a great environment to cut times and improve technique," said Baker. "Back home at COM Aquatics, I am coached by Coach Legend and Coach Tyler, and here I can get additional advice on how to improve."

You can catch Landon Baker swimming additional events on Saturday. I'm betting on one being the 100m Freestyle.
